

Graduate students admitted from the academic year 2018-2019 onwards are required to pass six hours of academic ethics courses according to the regulations of the academic ethics courses.

You can go on the website, <http://ethics.nctu.edu.tw/> to take the academic ethics courses.

After entering the website, please click on “English” on the upper right corner. Then, select “Mandatory Student” from the drop-down list of the category under “Login”. The account is your student number and the default of the password is the last 5 digits of your student number. After logging in, if you want to change your password or e-mail address, you can click on “Account” at the top of the page. If you want to start classes, please click on “Courses”→”My Courses”, and you can access the Research Ethics Education Online Program.

After you complete the courses and pass the final exam, you may download the certificate of completion after the noon of the next day. The record will also appear on your transcript.
