**1. Degree examination reviewer compensation (per thesis/dissertation reviewed)**

Master's program	Doctoral program

**2. Thesis/dissertation advisor compensation**

<b>Master's program</b>	<b>Doctoral program</b>
<b>NT\$ 4,000 per thesis</b>	<b>NT\$ 6,000 per dissertation</b>

- 1) Each thesis/dissertation may only be eligible for the foregoing compensation amount once, and no additional amount may be issued for canceled or make-up examinations.
- 2) An advisor must be a full-time or part-time faculty member of the University.
- 3) For graduate students with two (or three) co-advisors, each co-advisor shall be eligible for 0.5 (or 0.33) times the foregoing compensation amount.

**3. Transportation allowance for degree examination committee members**

- 1) Transportation allowances shall be granted to non-NTU committee members only.
- 2) The following standard shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to transportation allowances for non-NTU members serving on a master's/doctoral (candidacy) qualifying examination committee, adjustable based on actual circumstances.

The **payment** amount shall be determined according to the city/county in which the non-NTU committee member is based:

In certain exigencies, an in-service master's program may, with the express approval of the Administrative Meeting, increase its compensation for thesis advisors by up to the equivalent of two hours of lecture fees for the program. The program shall be responsible for paying the difference using its self-raised revenues.
5. These standards shall **take effect in Academic Year 2020–21**, following the approval of the Administrative Meeting and the University Endowment Fund Management Committee.
