Teacher Education Credit Fees	Student teachers enrolled in NTU's Teacher Education program must pay Teacher Education credit fees in accordance with the regulations of the Teacher Education program. Standard fees shall be charged in accordance with those of bachelor's degree classes in the College of Liberal Arts, Social Sciences, and Law. Except for those who meet the criteria for withdrawal or suspension of study, students may not apply for refund. Non-student teachers who take courses offered by the Teacher Education program and pass the examination to become a student teacher shall pay Teacher Education credit fees at the Cashier Division and apply for credit exemption.
Physical Education Credit Fees	Undergraduate students who have extended their degree and have nine or fewer general or Teacher Education credits will be billed separately in accordance with College of Liberal Arts credit fee standards.
Internship Advising Fee	In accordance with the regulations of the NTU Teacher Education program, student teachers participating in a half-year full-time educational internship must pay an educational internship advising fee equivalent to four credits.
