Regulations Governing Student ID Card Reissuance and Replacement

- October 16, 2009 Amended Articles 2–4 passed by the 1st Academic Affairs Meeting, fall semester, Academic Year 2009–10
- October 24, 2014 Amended Article 1 passed by the 1st Academic Affairs Meeting, fall semester, Academic Year 2014–15
- Article 1 Students who lose or damage their National Taiwan University (NTU or "the University") student ID card may apply for a reissuance or replacement with the Undergraduate/Graduate Academic Affairs Division of the Office of Academic Affairs, or the Branch Office of Academic Affairs, College of Medicine.

Article 2 Application procedures:

- 1. Report the loss of the student ID card online.
- 2. Pay the processing fee of NT\$ 150 at a self-service kiosk or at the Cashier Division, and take the application stub to the responsible academic affairs division at the Office of Academic Affairs for processing.
- Article 3 Graduating students who lose their student ID card during the school-leaving process shall first report the loss of their card online and then present a form of identification to receive their diploma.
- Article 4 The Regulations Governing Student ID Card Reissuance and Replacement shall be passed by the Academic Affairs Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
